Incentive amounts can change without notice. Good/Better/Best options are defined based on equipment efficiency levels. Customers can upgrade more than one piece of equipment with different efficiency levels. For example, upgrading a 97% AFUE furnace (Best) with a 17 SEER air conditioner (Better) could make you eligible for a total rebate of \$650.

**Note: Air Source and Ground Source Heat Pumps are only eligible for customers who are replacing an existing heat pump system, and use electricity as their primary heating fuel. Ductless Mini-Split Heat Pumps are eligible for customers who are replacing a heat pump or electric resistance heating.
